

8:15 coaches meeting player expectation

Welcome to the South Central 2018 Curling Zone Bonspiel. I am the Assistant Principal at Cochrane High Glenn Brooker and Program Coordinator for Spray Lakes is Morgan Muise. We will be assisting you with all questions you may have today. Morgan will talk about keeping the facility clean and if you have any rules or etiquette of play questions please seek her out. She will do her best to help you.

Glenn or Morgan: Please inform all Coaches and Skips:

- Coaches:
- **After the first game each team will make a draw to the button for tiebreakers**
- **All games will be eight ends duration. If tied at the completion of eight ends, an extra end or ends shall be played.**
- **iii. Competition in each event shall be two section round robins. At the completion of the round robin, the first place team from each pool will play the second place team from the opposite pool. The winners play to determine the gold and silver medal winners, and the losing teams play to determine the bronze medal winner.**
- Tie Breaker Policy ASAA- posted -so I will just go over it quickly-
- i. If two teams are tied for first, the game between the two teams will determine first and second places.
- ii. The tie-breaking procedure will include a draw to the button to take place after the conclusion of each practice, by all teams involved in the competition. The measurements of the three round robin games will be recorded and totaled for tie breaking placing only.
- 1. If three teams are tied for first, the team with the lowest total draw to the button will be awarded 1st place in the pool. The other two teams will play a four-end game to determine the 2nd place team. Extra ends will be played if necessary.
- 2. If three teams are tied for second place, the team with the lowest total draw to the button will be awarded a bye. The other two teams will play a four-end game with the winner then playing the team with the bye in another four-end game to determine 2nd place in the pool. Extra ends will be played if necessary.
- Again this is posted- and any questions can be directed to us as you need.
- Each team is permitted to take two 60-second timeouts per game. The time outs must be taken when the team is in possession of the rock. They may be called by the skip or coach. The time outs cannot be carried forward to the extra end(s).
- One 60-second timeout is available to each team for the extra end.
- A five minute break is allowed after the 4th end. Coaches are permitted to out on walkway or teams may come in for their break
- Be mindful that games will still be going on and do your best wait until the player you are walking by leaves the hack.
- Competitions shall use the four rock free guard Zone rule currently used by the Canadian Curling Association
- ASAA will continue to allow all broom heads with the exception of hair brooms or broom heads that are “textured, sealed, or modified from its original form” or that have hardening or stiffening inserts- which are NOT allowed. In short, ASAA will continue to follow the 2015 World Curling Federation memorandum not the 2016 memorandum.
- Thirds will coin toss for hammer and colour of stones 20 mins prior to each draw time.
- Are there any questions. Once again- seek myself or Morgan out if you have any question.
- Please find your teams- toss your coin and Team who wins the toss will practice first 8:24
